### **Washington Hospital Employee Brings Home the Gold** *Team USA wins World Cup Competition*

**Fremont, Calif.** – Adrian Zamora, stationary engineer at Washington Hospital, has brought home a gold medal from the World Cup of Table Soccer (Foosball). Adrian was part of the U.S. National Table Soccer Team that travelled to Nantes, France to compete recently in a tournament against 30 countries from around the world. The U.S. team cruised through a preliminary round and then went on to beat four European teams in the elimination round to win the title.

“I had a great time and it was quite a thrill to win the championship,” Zomora says. “I felt really good when I was playing and I only became nervous when I was rooting on my teammates.”

Zomora played in several singles and doubles matches during the tournament and he scored the winning goal in the gold medal match against the Netherlands. He also officiated several matches during the tournament.

Zomora has been a world-class table soccer player for several years and he was one of nine players selected to play for the U.S. team. He travels two or three times a year to play in competitive tournaments.
