#### **EVERY 40 SECONDS**

Someone has a stroke every 40 seconds in the U.S.



## **3 HOURS TO ER**

People who get to the ER within 3 hours of first symptoms have less disability post-stroke.



35% UNDER 65

35% of people hospitalized for stroke are under 65.



1 IN 4 ARE REPEATS

Nearly 1 in 4 stroke patients have had a previous stroke.
