

In January, Trustees voted to disburse **\$2,009,354.31** to Washington Hospital to support a range of programs from oncology to palliative care and many more. The Foundation disbursed over \$1.37M to the Hospital to support construction of the new UCSF-Washington Cancer Center on the Fremont Campus. Additionally, over \$209,000 was disbursed to help purchase life-saving equipment for the future trauma center, including a blood bank and infuser, and a mobile ultrasound.

In 2023, you supported Washington Hospital with over \$211,000 in funds for equipment and training to support, trauma readiness. Donations from the community helped purchase:

- A Fujifilm Sonosite Mobile Ultrasound to facilitate faster and more accurate patient care during emergencies
- A Helmer blood storage refrigerator to increase availability of blood for transfusions during trauma activations
- A Harloff Medical Storage Unit to provide trauma staff with rapid access to medical supplies
- Training for 12 Hospital staff at the 2023 East Bay Trauma Symposium, which provides collaborative, evidence-based training for safe and effective trauma care.
- Access to the Society of Trauma Nurses' electronic library of trauma lectures- a leading industry resource on trauma care



## **Elevating Oncology Care**

Opening in 2025, the new, 15,000 square foot UCSF – Washington Cancer Center will help meet the rising patient demand for academic-level oncology care in our community- providing holistic oncology care to patients throughout our community, without having to leave home and family.

The cancer center brings comprehensive oncology care delivered by UCSF specialty and subspecialty physicians to our local community. Recently, the cancer center has increased the number of clinical trials available to patients and has added UCSF oncology We are energized by this opportunity for growth and are looking forward to our community's continued support of this important effort and the impact it will have on the future for generations to come. Thanks to our community's support at the 37th Annual Top Hat Gala and commitments from community members and many local businesses, such as Fremont Bank, the Foundation has been able to support with initial construction costs of the new center. 
### Share your Gratitude
