I am thrilled to share some exciting updates with you, highlighting the significant progress we've made together. Firstly, I want to express my heartfelt gratitude to all who contributed to the success of the **37th**Annual Golf & Bocce Tournament on May 2nd. Thanks to your participation, we raised over \$124,000 in gross proceeds,

I am also excited to announce that in April, the Foundation made its largest disbursement in history to the Hospital, totaling \$4.7 million. These funds will support a range of clinical services and programs, with a significant portion earmarked for the new UCSF-Washington Cancer Center, slated to open in 2026. Over the past year, we have distributed over \$6.7 million to the Hospital, bringing our total disbursements since inception to an impressive \$30 million.
